The Dental Board of California previously published pass rates for the Registered Dental Assisting Law and Ethics and Written exams separately, but published one combined rate for 2018-2019. The reported number of students transferring to 4-year universities includes transfers to UC and CSU only, per COM institution set standard.

Annual unduplicated enrollment figures include leading summer, fall and spring semester

enrollment as of first census day.
