Recommended Action	The Superintendent/President recommends that the Board of Trustees authorize the District to proceed with the construction contract award to the lowest responsive responsible bidder, CCT, for the SecureAll Electronic Hardware Infrastructure Installation Phase 2 project in the amount of \$59,820.

BACKGROUND

On April 21, 2015 the Board approved Authorization to Bid and Pre- Authorization to Award a Construction Contract for the SecureAll Electronic Hardware Infrastructure Installation – Phase 2 for the estimated construction contract amount of \$47,000. The scope of the work includes installing hardware on interiors doors of existing facilities on the Kentfield campus which requires the installation of additional infrastructure to support the electronic hardware functions. The added infrastructure includes WAPS (wireless access points) and data wiring and conduit routing as required.

A total of 6 contractors were contacted to attend the mandatory bid walk in addition to the two standard public bid advertisements and listing of the project at 5 local Builders' exchanges. Two bidders attended the mandatory pre-bid walk and only one submitted a bid.

The bid received was in the amount of \$59,820 which is \$12,820 above the pre-approved construction amount of \$47,000.

At this time the Board of Trustees is asked to authorize award of a design-build construction contract to the lowest responsive responsible bidder, CCT, for the SecureAll Electronic Hardware Infrastructure Installation Phase 2 project in the amount of **\$59,820**.
