

COM Credit Students: Highest High School Math and First Major at COM, Spring 2017-Spring 2018

1. What percent of students come to COM having already passed Algebra 2, Intermediate Algebra (or similarly titled course)? Can we break that down by intent (ie stem vs lib arts etc)

1,684 students enrolled at COM from Spring 2017 through Spring 2018 (3 semesters) who had self-reported the highest high school math course they had taken and the grade for that course. Of these, 426 (25%) had passed Algebra 2 with a C or better. We're uncertain about which of these courses are higher level than Algebra 2.

Of 8,810 credit students enrolled from Spring 2017-Spring 2018, 245 (2.8%) reported not having received a high school diploma or currently being enrolled in adult school; 1,220 (13.9%) were concurrently enrolled high school students.
