Examples of Comments

Environmental sensitivity could be read as illness/allergies/MCS maybe ethics/understanding/judiciousness/competency would be better.

I don't think that the "strong foundation of sustainability..." portion really applies. While it applies to the choices made with the Measure C building, I do not think that it applies across disciplines to the education that students receive at COM.

Sustainability aligns with our 4 Es, not just the environment. You could add the 4 Es to clarify sustainability.

"Foundation of sustainability/environmental sensitivity" should be reworked. Something like Social and Environmental responsibility.
