
Q1 STUDENT TRANSPORTATION FEE TO SUPPORT FREE BUS PASSES AND **EXPANDED ROUTES IN MARIN COUNTY** Shall the Board of Trustees of the Marin Community College District require all College of Marin students enrolled in one or more units of credit or non-credit instruction, during fall, spring, or summer semesters, to pay a transportation fee? The fee would enable College of Marin students to receive access to free local bus transportation via Marin Transit during their enrollment period. In addition to free access to all current transit services, better service to College of Marin is planned and would be included with the pass. Potential service enhancements include a new direct shuttle from the Kentfield campus to the San Rafael Transit Center in Downtown San Rafael and a limited express shuttle between the **Kentfield Campus and the Indian Valley** Campus on school days. Students who enroll in credit or non-credit classes for the fall semester will receive free local bus transportation through the winter break and until the first day of spring semester. Students who enroll in credit or non-credit classes for the spring semester will receive free local bus transportation until the first day of fall semester. Students who enroll in credit or non-credit classes for the summer semester will receive free local bus transportation until the first day of fall semester. The fee per semester for fall and spring will be \$3 per unit up to 12 units, with a maximum amount of \$35 for 12 units or more. The fee for summer semester will be \$4.50 per unit up to 4 units, with a maximum amount of \$18 for 4 units or more. The Transportation Fee, if approved by a majority vote of students who cast ballots on this measure, will be a mandatory fee for

all College of Marin students registered in the fall, spring, or summer semesters.


