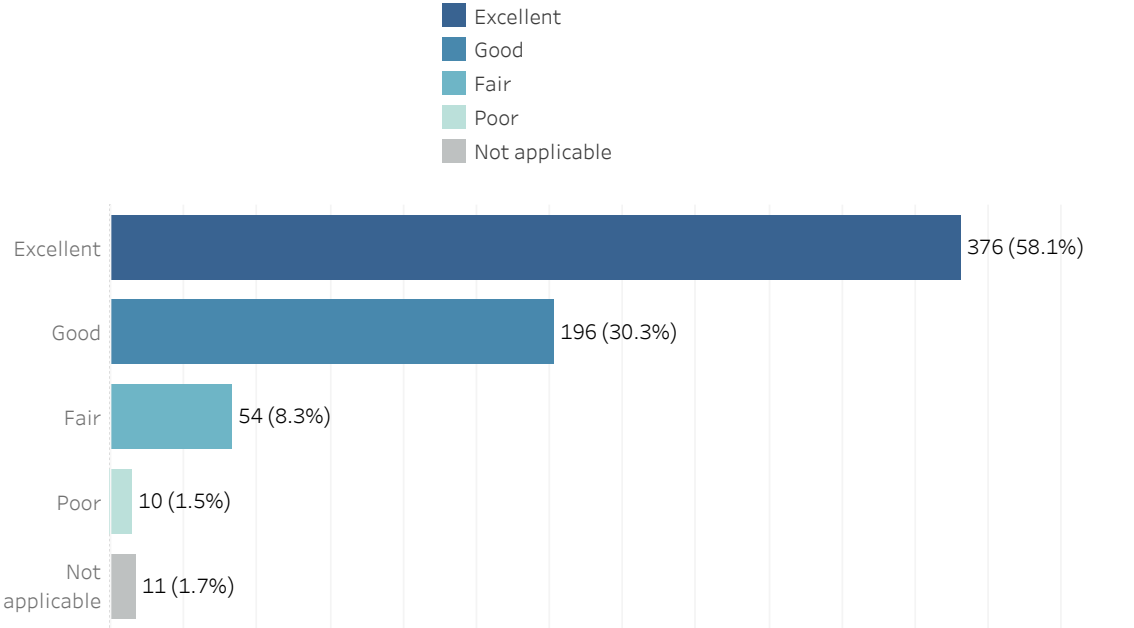


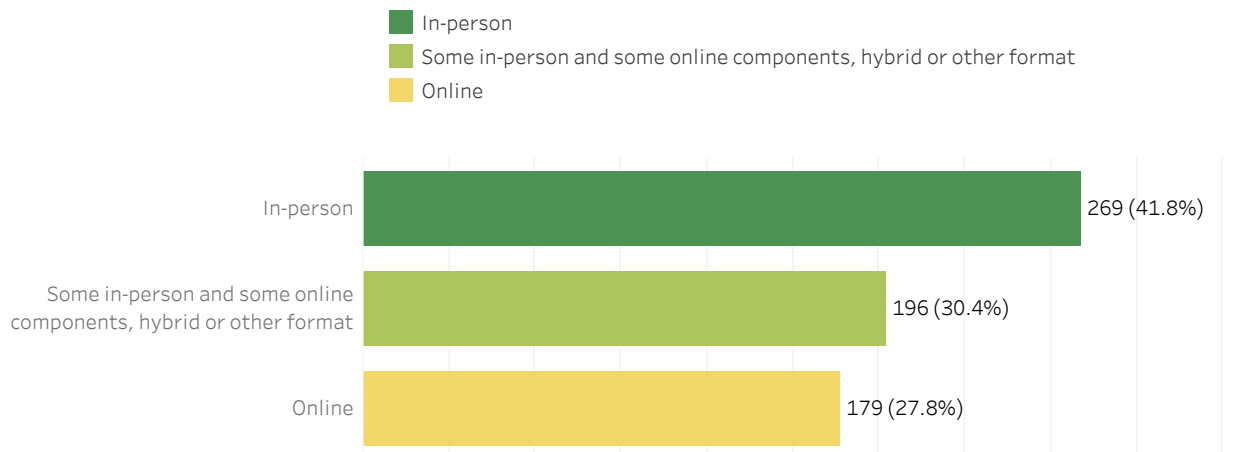
Spring 2022 Community Education Student Survey Results

Q1. Overall, how would you describe the quality of your learning experience(s) in Community Education?

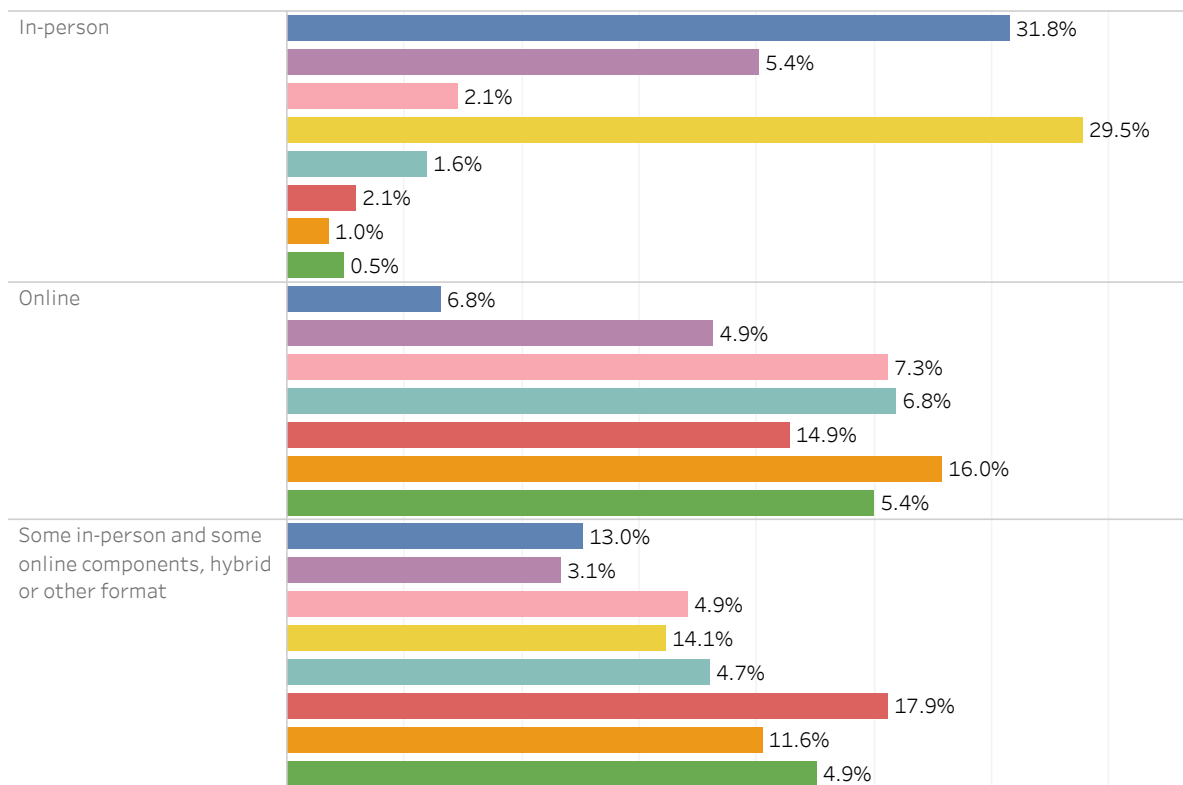

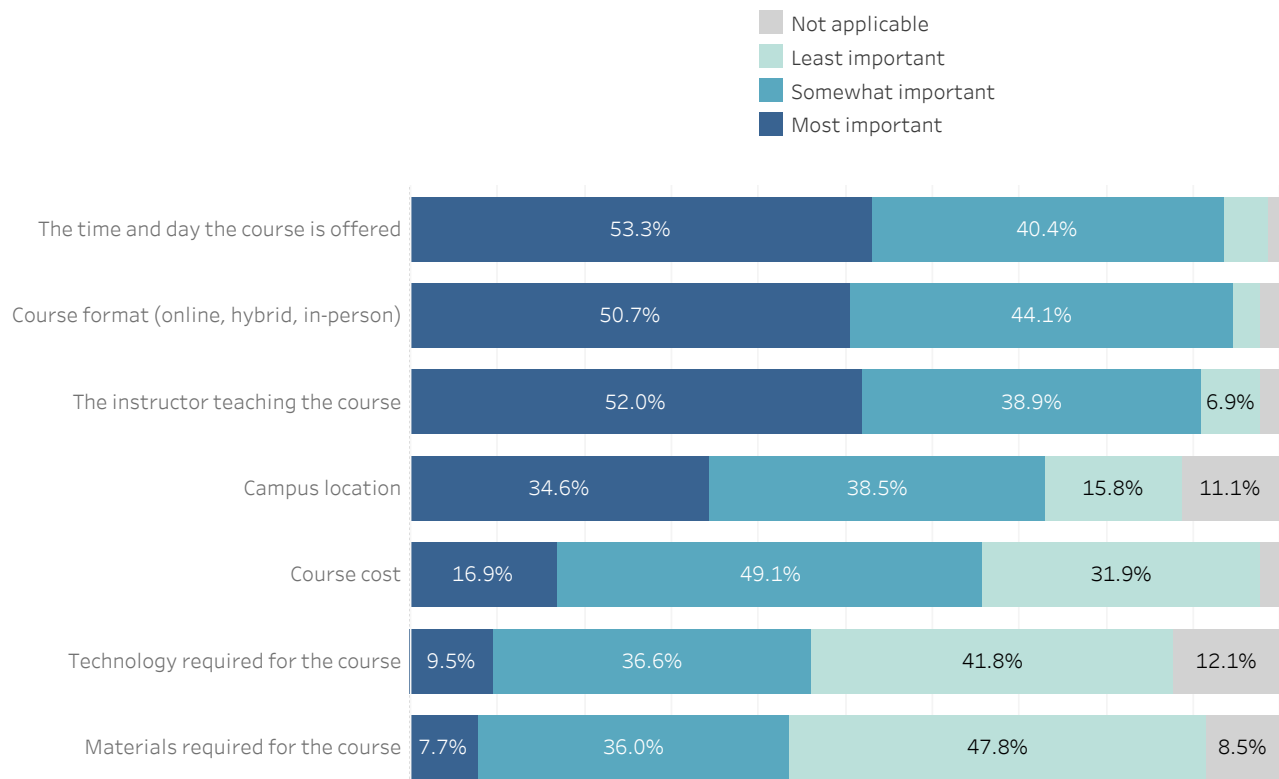


Q3. What are the main reasons you prefer [online/in-person/some online and some in person] courses?

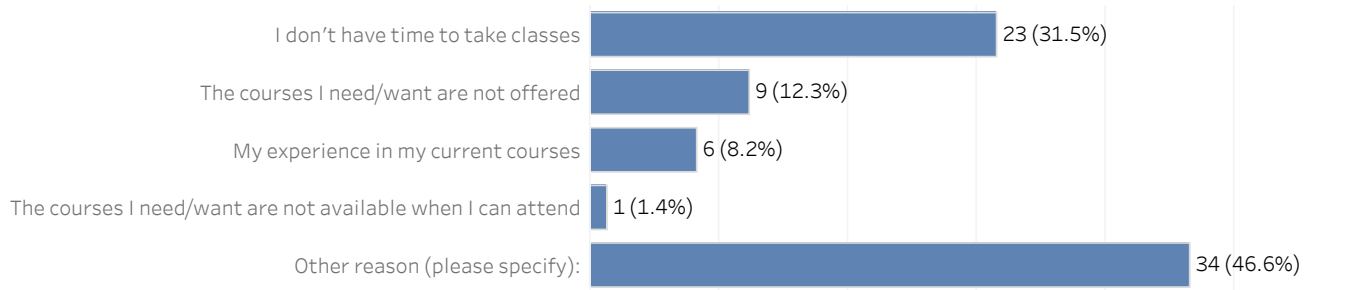
