Applying for Financial Aid

To be considered for Federal Financial Aid (Pell Grants, Direct Loans, and Federal Work-Study) students will first need to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, commonly known as the FAFSA.

File your FAFSA here. Filing your FAFSA online is highly encouraged and is the fastest and easiest way to apply for financial aid. The application is available in English and Spanish and is available 24/7. For California residents who are not eligible to file a FAFSA, you may apply for the California Dream Application.
