It shall be the policy of the Board to offer opportunities for participation in intercollegiate athletic programs to students, in accordance with state and federal guidelines and California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) standards. The program shall not discriminate on the basis of gender in the availability of athletic opportunities.

The Superintendent/President shall assure that the athletics program complies with state and federal law, the CCCAA and Sports Championship Handbooks, and appropriate Conference Constitution regarding student athlete participation.

Accidental death insurance and limited insurance protection for medical and hospital expenses resulting from accidental bodily injury is provided for all students, including each member of the College athletic teams. The District's student accident insurance is supplemental to any personal insurance policies that cover the student.
