WHAT IS COM CARE?

College of Marin Crisis Assessment, Response, and Education Team

Purpose of COM CARE and the COM CARE Team

- To assist instructors and staff as they identify concerns or troubling behavior related to a student's personal or academic progress, i.e., personal issues, absences, failing academic performance, failure to turn in assignments, etc.
- To provide assistance and referral for students having difficult personal or academic concerns. This may include an academic intervention through Counseling in collaboration with you, or behavioral intervention by the Student Conduct Officer or other designated Care Team members.
- To report and address concerns regarding the wellbeing or behavior of another individual on campus.
