- As such, we participate and advise in the governance of the college
- One way we participate is through the Participatory Governance System committees that make recommendations in specific areas:

# Planning and Resource Allocation

PRAC provides oversight and makes recommendations for institutional planning and resource allocation.

# Educational Planning

Ed Planning is responsible for coordinating and setting goals for planning broad educational endeavors at the College.

# Facilities Planning

Facilities Planning ensures faculty, staff and student involvement in the planning, design, construction, upkeep and use of College-owned facilities.

# Student Access and Success

Student Access/Success reviews institutional plans and data relating to equity, access and success, in order to ensure alignment of resources and efforts with institution-set indicators and goals.

# Instructional Equipment

Instructional Equipment recommends allocations for instructional equipment.

# Professional Development

The PDC is responsible for overseeing professional development planning, programs and evaluation in support of the College Mission, institutional plans and initiatives, accreditation and legal requirements.

# Technology Planning

Technology Planning assures staff and faculty involvement in technology planning and provide guidance for major technological decisions.

## Governance Review Council

GRC monitors and evaluate the governance process and recommends changes and revisions to the system.

# College Council

College Council serves as an advisory group to the Superintendent President and acts as a two-way communication vehicle for recommendations and proposals that come through the participatory governance system.



# All governance committees have:

- Students appointed by ASCOM
- Classified Staff appointed by the Classified Professional Liaison Committee (CPLC), a joint committee of CSEA, SEIU, and the Classified Senate
- Faculty appointed by the Academic Senate
- Administrators appointed by the superintendent/president

# As Committee Members We:

- Serve two year terms
- Attend meetings once or twice a month
- Keep our constituent group informed of the committee's work
- Participate in making recommendations
- Make committee decisions by consensus
