Education Code Sections 72023, 72103, and 72104;
ACCJC Accreditation Standard IV.C.6.

The Board shall consist of seven members elected at large from the District and a student member.
Any person who meets the criteria contained in law is eligible to be elected or appointed a member of the Board of Trustees.

An employee of the District may not be sworn into office as an elected or appointed member of the Board of Trustees unless he/she/they resigns as an employee.

No member of the Board of Trustees shall, during the term for which he/she/they is elected, hold an incompatible office.

No member of the Governing Board shall, during the term for which he/she/they was elected, be eligible to serve on the governing board of a high school district whose boundaries are coterminous with those of the Marin Community College District.
