

**District Directed**  
**Fall 2019: Math Companion Course Instructional Support**

Applications are being solicited from College of Marin's full-time and part-time Math faculty members who will be teaching companion courses Fall 2019. Faculty members will be selected to each receive (.5) unit.

**Description and Rationale for Position:**

This position falls under the administrative leadership of the Dean of Math and Sciences. The function of this work is to collaborate with department members as part of the implementation of AB 705.

**Scope of Work:**

The faculty members will:

- Meet once a week on hour with Math faculty teaching companion courses.
- Research best practices and curriculum used in Math co-requisite courses.
- Collaborate with Math Faculty and share best practices including material and curriculum.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Full time or part time Math faculty status at College of Marin
- Must be teaching a companion course Fall 2019
- Demonstrated sensitivity to and an understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, ethnic, and accessibility-related backgrounds of community college students and the campus community.

**Evaluation Criteria (Article 8.3.3):**

The applicant(s) appears to have adequate experience and/or training to carry out the proposed appointment (0-5 points).

Number of years since last award to recipient: [5 years or never awarded = 5 points; 4 years = 4 points; 3 years = 3 points; 2 years = 2 points; 1 year = 1 point; less than 1 year = 0 points].
