Students Taking Math 103A/B, Fall 2014 through Spring 2019: Enrollment Patterns and Throughput to Transfer-Level Math

- A total of 293 students took either MATH 103 A or B in the past 5 years (2014-15 through 2018-19).
- The largest proportion of these students (112, 38%) started in MATH103A. A substantial proportion (89, 30%) enrolled in MATH103 unsuccessfully prior to enrolling in 103A or B. Most of the rest took a lower level math course first, though a few either 1) took 103X or another course, then 103B, or 2) started in 103B.
- Of all students taking either 103A or 103B, 92 (31%) have enrolled in, and 76 (26%) have successfully completed, a transfer-level math course (104 or higher) as of Spring 2019.
- Of all students taking either 103A or 103B, 81 (27%) took either Math115 or STAT115; 70 (86% of those taking a 115 course) successfully completed (data not shown).
